







Official rules of Football 7, with some adjustments:

- There must be at least 3 elements of one gender present on the field; the remaining players are thus belonging to the other gender;
- The teams are formed by 10 to 12 players (7 active players and 3 to 5 reserve players);
- Playing time: two halves of 10 minutes each;
- Break: 1 minute (field exchange);
- Faults and anti-sports behaviour: Upon each fault, the player will be forced to leave the game for a length of two minutes; if the same player repeats the fault, he / she will be expelled from the game and the team to which he / she belongs reduced to 6 active players.



Official rules of Basketball, with some adjustments:

- There must be at least 2 elements of one gender present on the fields; the remaining players are thus belonging to the other gender;
- The teams are formed by 8 to 10 players (5 active players and 3 to 5 reserve players);
- Playing time: two halves of 10 minutes each (run time);
- Break: 2 minutes (field exchange);
- Each team can call for a period of time-out during each half;
- An accumulation of 4 faults by an individual player leads to his / her expulsion of the game;
- A total of four faults by the team leads to 2 free strikes by the opponent team;
- Any anti-sports behaviour leads to an immediate expulsion of the game;
- In case of a draw at the end of the determined playing game in semi finals (during the group matches there can be draws), there will be 3 free strikes for each team by different players; if the draw situation remains, the free strikes will be kept until the first team misses to score ("golden point").

BEACH VOLLEYBALL

Official rules of Beach Volleyball, with some adjustments:

- There must be at least 2 elements of one gender present on the fields; the remaining players are thus belonging to the other gender;
- The teams are formed by 4 to 6 players (4 active players and 1 to 2 reserve players);
- Playing time: the best of 3 sets of 15 points each (tiebreak game);
- During the third set and upon the eighth point, there will be a field exchange;
- Break: field exchange;
- Any anti-sports behaviour leads to an immediate expulsion of the game;

Official rules of Swimming, with some adjustments:

- The teams are formed by 4 swimmers: 2 male and 2 female;
- Swimming competition: preliminaries of 3 eliminatory series of
 - 50 m Butterfly (Women and Men);
 - 50 m Backstroke (Women and Men);
 - 50 m Stroke (Women and Men);
 - 50 m Freestyle (Women and Men);
 - 4x50 m Freestyle Relay (Mixed).
- After the preliminary series, the finals will take place in each of the categories mentioned above;
- Each swimmer shall take part of two individual competitions;
- Each swimmer shall bring a cap, a bathing suit (female) or shorts (male), all appropriate for swimming competitions;

TENNIS

<u>Official rules of Tennis</u>, (according to International Tennis Federation) with some adjustments:

- The teams are formed by 4 players: 2 male and 2 female(matches: male singles, female singles and mixed doubles;
- Playing time: Single draws (Women and Men) and Double draws (Mixed) of 15 minutes each (tiebreak game); (Should the match reach the limit of the defined length of 15 minutes during a rally, the referee shall allow the rally to come to an end);
- Upon each 12th point, the players will exchange the field;
- The participants of the Single draws cannot play at the Double draws and vice-versa.
- The first players in the ranking of each group and the best second will pass to the semi-finals;
- The balls will be supplied by the tournament's organisation and will be swapped anytime the referee considers it necessary;
- Any other situation not included here will be solved by the referee and the director of the match;
- There will be a hardcourt where the players can warm up;
- The matches will take place in a synthetic grass court of Parque Municipal de Ténis in Cantanhede.
